- Handog-Kaibigan scholarship



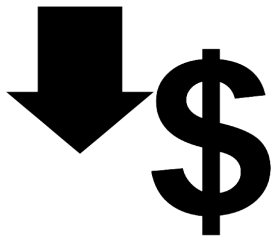
Cost effectiveness
